

Course Syllabus for 6th Grade Art

Overview:

Students will be introduced to the seven elements of art. They will study, experience and create projects that utilize line, form, shape, color, value, texture, and space. Each art project will illustrate the students understanding of these art elements.

In this course, students will also begin to recognize famous artists and their paintings. They will develop skills of observation and begin to critically examine art so they can make informed decisions about art in their visual world. Students will develop an appreciation for individual styles, artistic differences and creative uniqueness. A variety of two and three-dimensional art mediums will be explored.

Learn that understanding the art of other cultures helps artists understand and appreciate their own culture and uniqueness.
