ACADEMIC STIPENDS</p> <p>The Board shall consider a monetary reimbursement stipend for students who exhaust all of the district's highest course offerings in a particular curriculum and take more advance courses through college/university options.</p> <p>The eligibility criteria is as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A student must have taken all the courses in a particular curriculum (by exhausting the highest levels of courses) to be eligible for a stipend. 2. If the student meets the above criteria, the district would pay a total maximum stipend of \$250 per course, per year. This includes tuition and course related materials (i.e., texts, etc.). 3. There is an annual district budget cap totaling \$2,000 for all eligible students combined. 4. Academic stipend eligibility approval must be granted by the administration prior to registration and enrollment. Reimbursement is contingent on successful (passing) completion of the course. 5. Distance learning courses must meet the above criteria to receive the stipend. However, students may take distance learning courses without meeting one or all of the above criteria, but they would forfeit stipend eligibility.
