

BRANDYWINE HEIGHTS HIGH SCHOOL PARKING RULES 2018-2019

Driving a vehicle to school is a privilege, not a right. BHHS reserves the right to search or tow any vehicle and/or suspend or revoke student-parking privileges. Furthermore, Brandywine Heights High School reserves the right to modify these rules at any time. All persons and vehicles on BHHS parking lots must adhere to the policies presented in the BHHS Parking Rules.

BHHS PARKING/DRIVING RULES

BHHS students who drive to school are expected to:

1. Know the BHHS parking rules
2. Adhere to the BHHS parking rules, and
3. Accept the consequences for violating any BHHS parking rule(s).
4. All student vehicles parked on campus must have an annual permit with the vehicle licensed to the student and /or parent(s)/guardian(s) listed on the permit application form.
5. Motor vehicles driven on school grounds must conform to the regulations of the State of PA. All vehicles parked on school property are subject to search by an administrator at any time due to reasonable suspicion.
6. Student must sign the BHHS parking permit agreement before receiving a permit.
7. Students are to park only in their assigned lots, using only one parking spot.
8. Students are not to drive recklessly.
9. Students are not to move cars during the school day, except to leave campus legitimately.
10. Students are not to use vehicles to leave campus unexcused.
11. Speed limit is 15 MPH
12. Student are not permitted to go to their cars during the school day, without explicit permission from a high school administrator.
13. Students are required by law to wear their seatbelts at all times.

DISPLAY

Display your permit on the vehicle's right top corner of windshield (passenger's side). Vehicles with parking permits that do not display permits properly may result in the permit being revoked.

ELIGIBILITY

BHHS Students must purchase their permits in person. No student may purchase a permit for another student. ****Students who receive detention (s) during the current school year and do not serve them by the deadline will have their parking permit suspended until their detention (s) have been served.

PARKING PERMITS

Students who drive to BHHS must purchase a parking permit annually. To reserve a parking permit you must:

1. Pay the permit price,
2. Present an application form signed by the student and student's parent/guardian,
3. Present a valid driver's license, car registration and bus waiver (if applicable)
4. Sign the agreement to abide by Parking Rules.
5. Permits may be purchased for a vehicle registered to the student or his/her parent/guardian only. Permit applications and BHHS parking rules are available in the main office and on our website at www.bhasd.org click on high school. **PLEASE SUBMIT ALL PAPERWORK/PAYMENT/BUS WAIVER (IF APPLICABLE) TO THE MAIN OFFICE BY FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 7,2018.**

PERMITS

COST (Prices are subject to change)

General lot: \$25.00

Permits purchased after 1st semester are prorated.

Permit for 2nd semester/3rd quarter - \$12.00

Permit for 2nd semester/4th quarter - \$6.00

*Fee is waived if bus waiver is provided to the transportation office in the Business office.

REFUNDS

There are no refunds for lost or stolen permits. Students who lose their original tag will be charged \$5.00 for a replacement tag. Students may not transfer or sell their permits to other student nor may students use their names to buy permits for other students.

The parking permit application is on the last page.

DRIVING & PARKING

Accidents

Students drive and park on campus at their own risk. Any accident that occurs should be reported to the Main office and state police.

Driving to and from Campus

Students must enter and leave the parking lot via the Main Entrance (next to school sign). Students cannot enter or exit from the bus entrance.

***Students should have their vehicles parked by 7:30 AM to ensure they arrive to class on time.

No Parking/No Driving Zones

Students must park in their assigned lot only using one parking space. Students cannot park in staff, visitor, or handicapped spaces. A vehicle parked illegally in a handicapped or visitor space may have their parking permit suspended/revoked.

Reckless Driving

Any person who drives any vehicle in such a manner as to indicate either a willful or wanton disregard for the safety of a person or property is guilty of reckless driving....(Ex: speeding, exhibition driving, driving on the grass, pulling in front of other drivers, not yielding to a pedestrian, revving an engine, screeching tires, sliding on the ice.) Student who drive recklessly are subject to consequences per district policy.

Search of Vehicle

Any vehicle on campus is subject to search by a school administrator. If the school official determines there is a reasonable suspicion that a school regulation has been violated, he/she may be assisted by a law enforcement officer. **Anything in a student's vehicle is understood to belong to that student.** All contraband (including, but not limited to, weapons, alcohol, drugs, fireworks, and other items inappropriate or disruptive to the school environment) will be confiscated. Students with inappropriate items in their vehicles may be subject to additional school consequences per district policy.

Suspension/Revocation

When a student's parking permit is suspended, the student and the vehicle BOTH are suspended from parking at BHHS. Students will meet with the assistant principal when their violations qualify for suspension or revocation. BHHS notifies the parents or guardians when their students' permit is suspended or revoked.

REMINDER: It is your responsibility to contact transportation during your suspension to make arrangements for bus transportation.

Theft/Vandalism

Our High School is not responsible for vandalism, injury, theft (including stolen permits), or damage to vehicles or items in the school parking lot.
