Authority

It is the policy of the Board that the district may conduct a summer program of remedial and/or enrichment instruction at the primary level, intermediate level, middle school level and high school level, for resident students of this district, and such other students as the Board may admit. [\[1\]](#)[\[2\]](#)[\[3\]](#)

In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board shall:

1. Employ teaching and administrative staff.
2. Purchase necessary books, materials, supplies, and equipment.
3. Utilize schools or other facilities required.

Planned instruction offered in summer school may be designed as credit or noncredit offerings. [\[4\]](#)

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for:

1. Planning the summer school curriculum.
2. Recommending appropriate staff appointments.
3. Student and staff assignments.
4. Evaluation and reporting on pupil progress.

Guidelines

Guidelines for the operation of summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions.

Students eligible for the district's summer school may include:

1. Resident students who are eligible for regular attendance in the public schools of this district.
2. Nonresident students whose age or grade level is appropriate to the course of study applied for.

Tuition fees established shall be charged to resident students and nonresident students.

The Board does not accept responsibility for transportation of any student.
